6 "SEC. 106. RIGHT NOT TO SUBSIDIZE UNION NON-REP7 RESENTATIONAL ACTIVITIES.

"No employee's union dues, fees, or assessments or 8 9 other contributions shall be used or contributed to any 10 person, organization, or entity for any purpose not directly 11 related to the labor organization's collective bargaining or 12 contract administration functions on behalf of the rep-13 resented unit employee unless the employee member, or 14 nonmember required to make such payments as a condi-15 tion of employment, authorizes such expenditure in writ-16 ing, after a notice period of not less than 35 days. An initial authorization provided by an employee under the 17

- 1~ preceding sentence shall expire not later than $1~{\rm year}$ after
- 2 the date on which such authorization is signed by the em-
- 3 ployee. There shall be no automatic renewal of an author-
- 4 ization under this section.".
